COMBINING SECTIONS & SHOW RULES

Sections may be combined as specified in the MHJA Show Packet. Points will be awarded in the appropriate section. If there are four entries in both section of a combined division, sections will be divided. To divide with three in a section, permission must be received from all entries involved. Divisions teligible for division: Green, Childrens/Adult Amateur, Junior/Amateur Owner, Small/Medium and Large Pony Hunter. Management may split Heads Up, Short Stirrup and Long Stirrup by age if class numbers are sufficient.

CLASSICS AND SPECIAL CLASSES – Horse/Rider combination must compete in a complete qualifying division to be eligible. The second O/F class in the qualifying division will count as the first round of the open hunter classic. Jumpers and their riders must compete in a complete jumper division at the show to be eligible for a jumper classic.

RIDING “NOT TO BE JUDGED” is not permitted at any MHJA horse show.

If necessary to expedite the horse show, a **DOTTED LINE RULE** will be put into effect. It will be marked on the posted courses.

POWER AND SPEED Add-Back Classes - Jumper #'s 404, 419, 414, 409, 424. A percentage of the Entry Fees for these classes will be paid out as prize money, Horse/rider combination must compete in at least one other class in the division to compete in Power and Speed class. Entry Fee: \$35 1st – 35%, 2nd – 25%, 3rd – 15%

SCRATCHING & ADDING CLASSES:

To avoid Scratch and Add fees, you must **ENTER IN THE OFFICE BEFORE** you ride in a class and you must **SCRATCH** in the office **BEFORE** the class begins.

\$15 penalty for each class ridden without entering, scratching or adding IN THE OFFICE!

THIS PENALTY ALSO APPLIES TO BLUE/RED RIBBON SCHOOLING CLASSES.

DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

Cross entering restrictions do not apply to AGE GROUP EQUITATION. Riders can always ride in their age group EQ. The MHJA Show Packet is the authority for any question about a MHJA rule.

HUNTER DIVISION

HEADS UP/HEELS DOWN - Classes open to beginner riders. No age restrictions. MAY NOT CROSS ENTER AT THIS HORSE SHOW into any classes except in the Head's Up section. Fences - Up to 12"

SHORT and LONG STIRRUP - SHORT STIRRUP open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior age 12 and under. NO CROSS ENTERING except age group equitation. LONG STIRRUP specs are the same except riders can be a junior or amateur over 12 years old. Will be combined if less than 6 in either section. Fences 18"-2'. MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

RED/BLUE SCHOOLING ROUNDS - Unlimited Schooling rounds can be ridden at a cost of \$30/class. Judge will award a numerical score - 70+ receives red, 80+ receives blue.

BABY GREEN - Open to horses in their first or second year of showing. Fences 2'6". MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

PRE-GREEN - Open to horses and ponies who have never shown over fences 3'6" or higher at a USEF show. Eligible PRE-GREEN two years once they begin the division. Fences 2'9" - 3'. MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

MHJA HUNTER PONY - Open to ponies ridden by a junior rider. Age restrictions as specified in USEF Pony Hunter. Fences 2' small and medium ponies, 2'6" large ponies. MHJA, LHJA, GC

PRE-CHILD/ADULT - Open to any junior or amateur on a horse or pony. RIDER MAY NOT CROSS ENTER WHERE FENCES exceed 2'9". Fences 2'3"-2'6". MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

MODIFIED-CHILD/ADULT - Open to any junior or amateur on a horse or pony. RIDER MAY NOT CROSS ENTER WHERE FENCES exceed 3'3". Fences 2'6"-2'9". MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

CHILDREN'S/ ADULT AMATEUR - Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior or adult amateur rider. Horse/Rider combination may not compete in Junior or Amateur Owner Hunter at this horse show. Fences 2'9"-3' (Zone IV). MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

JUNIOR/AMATEUR OWNER - Open to horses ridden by a junior or amateur. Amateurs or member of amateur rider's family must own the horse being exhibited. Fences 3'3"-3'6". MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

EQUITATION DIVISION

Points will be awarded in both Flat and O/F classes

SHORT & LONG STIRRUP EQ - For S&L Stirrup riders only. Fences 18"-2'. MHJA, LHJA, GC

PRE-CHILD/AD AM EQ - Fences 2'3". MHJA

EQUITATION 11 & UNDER - Tests 1 - 8; Fences 2'3"-2'6". MHJA

EQUITATION 12 - 14 - Tests 1 - 13; Fences 2'9"-3'. MHJA

EQUITATION 15 - 17 - Tests 1 - 19; Fences 3'3"-3'6". MHJA

CHILD/ADULT AM EQ - Tests 1 - 19; Fences 2'9"-3'. MHJA (ADULT LHJA, GCHJC)

MHJA PONY MEDAL - Conducted like USEF Pony Equitation except 3 riders must complete the course. Tests 1 - 9, Fence heights as in Pony Hunter. MHJA

MHJA HORSE MEDAL - Open to junior and amateur riders. Run like the USEF Hunter Seat EQ Medal except 3 riders must complete the course. Tests 1-19; Fences 2'9"-3'. MHJA

JUMPER DIVISION

HOPEFUL JUMPER - Open to any horse or pony who does not jump higher than 3'6" at this show. Fences 2'5", meter .70 - .75. MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

PONY JUMPER - Open to junior riders on ponies. Fences 2'9"-3', meter .85 - .90.

LOW SCHOOLING JUMPER - Open to horses/ponies not jumping higher than 3'6" at this show. Fences 2'9" - 2'11", meter .85 - .90. MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPER - Open to any horse or pony. Fences 3'3"-3'5", meter 1.00 - 1.05. MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

CHILD/ADULT JUMPER - Open to horses and junior/ amateur riders. Fences 3'3"-3'5", meter 1.00 - 1.05. MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC

JUNIOR/AMATEUR OWNER JUMPER - Open to horses and junior/amateur riders. Fences 3'9"-3'11", meter 1.15 - 1.20. MHJA, LHJA, GCHJC
